Dear Councilors and Council Personnel,

I am writing to object to the building and establishment of application 1212/2021, a large pokie pub to be situated on the Hume Highway replacing the current IBIS ACCOR HOTEL – CASULA at **437 Hume Highway Casula**.

We live close to this ridiculous application on the Hume Highway.

I am objecting on the following grounds:

- The entry and exit to the proposed hotel is via a narrow driveway and one-way entry into Grove Street. According to the documents, over 1000 cars will weave through our narrow residential streets and past our homes every day and night to get to Graham Avenue or De Meyrick Street to exit onto the Hume Highway.
- Grose Street has a narrow one-way entry only with a no exit sign onto the Hume Highway permitted. Every day significant numbers of cars carry drivers who break the law and exit via Grove Street onto the Hume Hwy regardless to signs and the direction of the lay back that should stop drivers entering the highway
- This unlawful daily offense is ignored and it continues daily.

The pub in Casula will cause misery to our residents. Build one away from the homes of our residents
